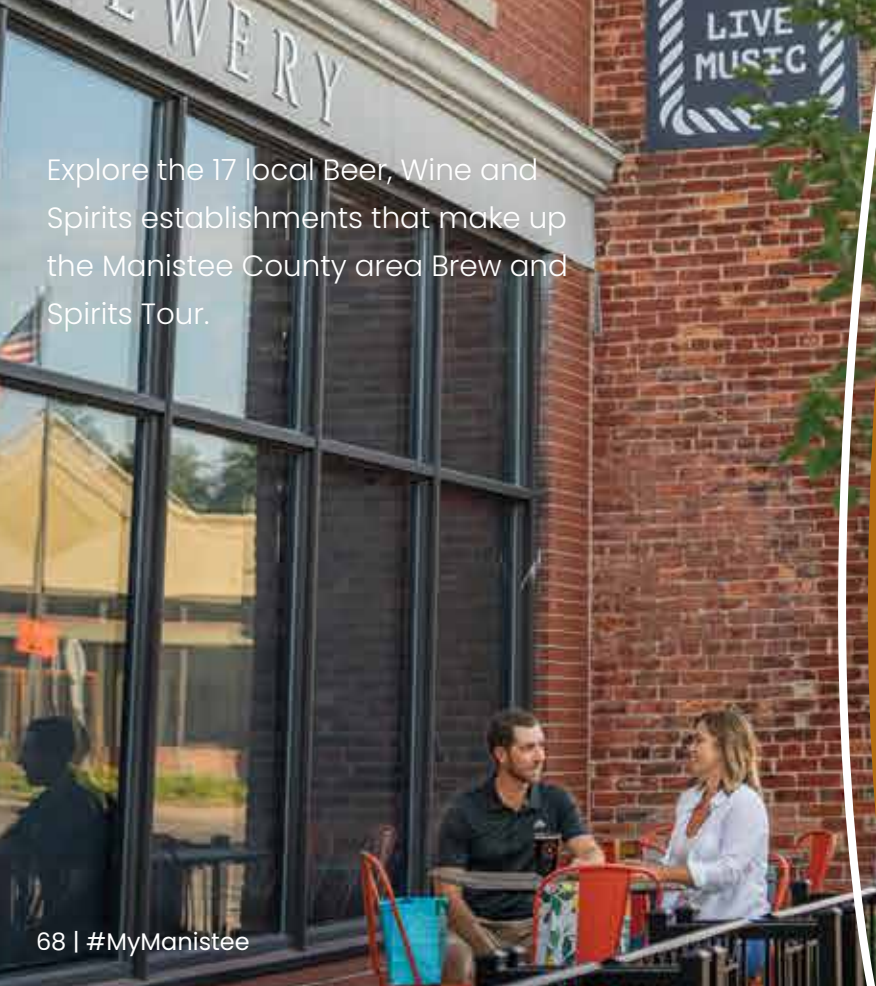

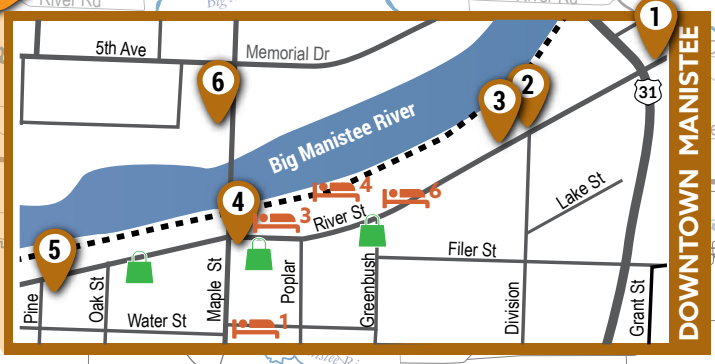
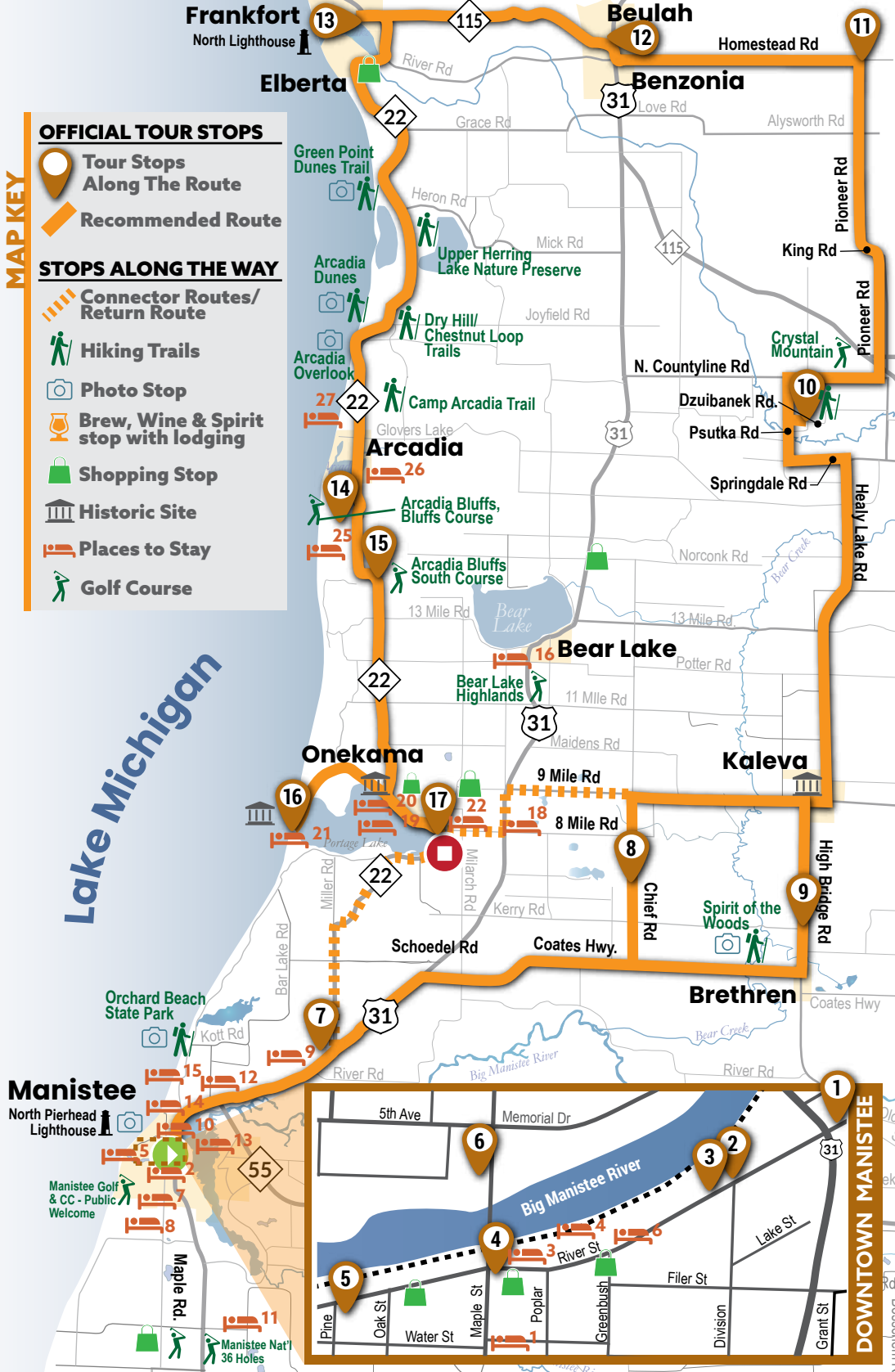

The Wile E Coyote - Gin, Mint, Lime Juice and Jalapeno infused simple syrup, is a signature drink and their bloody mary is out of this world. Be sure to check their website, as they are mixing up new cocktails all the time.*

## self-guided tours & origins walk

The Manistee County Historic Sites Series is the largest local effort to document, promote and share the rich history of the region. With over 150 sites along 6 routes and 1 cultural site, this is an incredible walk-through history experience.

### Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Cultural Corridor at the Little River Casino Resort

The finest place to discover true tribal history is at the Little River Casino Resort where the Cultural Corridor tells of this Anishinaabe (Ottawa) Indian tribe. The museum features mannequins displaying the authentic regalia, or attire, worn by tribal members. You will see the regalia of world champion dancers, movie actors and others, all of whom represent real tribal members of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians.
