HISTORIC

On your way through the county along the Brew & Spirits tour, check out these cool historic sites. You don't need to get out, just the view from the car is great!

Kaleva Bottle House 14551 Wuoski Ave., Kaleva

On National Historic Register and Ripley's Believe It or Not. Built by John Makinen in 1941 out of 60,000 bottles from the local bottling factory.

Portage Point Drive Artesian Well | Along Portage Pt. Dr.

Stop and fill up your water bottles at this fresh artesian well. It is some of the purest water in the region.

Portage Point Inn/Resort (Also home to Lahey's (#17)

Built nearly 120 years ago, this historic landmark has welcomed summer resorters for generations.
