Coastal Fall Color Tour



1 DOWNTOWN MANISTEE

Explore the shopping and dining opportunities in the heart of Downtown Manistee and enjoy the beautiful fall color along the banks of the Big Manistee River Channel as you stroll through town (see detail map on page 19).



2 ORCHARD BEACH STATE PARK



The park offers a great hike for the casual hiker. It's quick and scenic with many information stations along the trails. Learn about the natural history of the State Park and Manistee County shoreline. This is also a great spot for a morning cross country ski in the winter months. The nature trails are part of the state park, therefore a state park passport is required. You can obtain a pass at the ranger station in the park.



3 LAKE BLUFF TRAILS



Discover two of Michigan's Champion Trees - A Giant Sequoia and Sycamore. Wander the trails along this 1500' of Lake Michigan frontage. The rolling hills provide a beautiful backdrop of fall color.



4 BLUE SLIPPER BISTRO

11 GLEN PARK MINERAL SPRINGS




(8460 4th Ave, Onkama)
The area around the springs was platted Glen Park in 1916 and was later deeded back to Onkama Township for public access. Today, Glen Springs is one of the most picturesque places in Michigan. The Springs are located off of 4th Avenue in Onkama.



12 ARTESIAN WELL ON PORTAGE POINT DRIVE



Explore Portage Lake and Lake Michigan from this beautiful spot. Also check out the Artesian well along Portage Point Drive on your way to the Inn, or back towards M-22. It is about .25 miles down the road on the south side from the intersection of M-22 and Portage Point Drive. It contains some of the freshest spring-fed water in Michigan.

13 LAHEY'S PUB AT PORTAGE POINT RESORT

(8513 Portage Point Dr., Onekama)
Serving Michigan craft beer, wine and craft cocktails, plus specialty menus with fresh local favorites, such as appetizers, pizzas, salads and wraps. Fri., Sat. and Sun. through mid-October.

14 PORTAGE POINT RESORT

(8567 Portage Point Dr, Onekama)
Open all year, stop by to see why it's known as the sister resort to the Grand Hotel on Mackinac Island. Resort has been a destination for families since the turn of the 20th Century.

15 PIERPORT AREA

As you continue north along M-22, you will come across a whole host of farm markets and fruit stands during the fall season. Pick your giant pumpkins and take them home for carving. You will also find many seasonal vegetables available that were grown by 4th and 5th generation farming families in Manistee County.

16 ARCADIA BLUFFS - SOUTH COURSE

(13637 Northwood Highway, M-22, Bear Lake) Play well into October at this premier course situated along Scenic M-22 on 311-acres just south of the Bluffs Course. The South Course at Arcadia Bluffs is a tribute to a bygone era in golf course design that few golfers today have ever experienced.

17 ARCADIA BLUFFS - BLUFFS COURSE

(14710 Northwood Highway, M-22, Arcadia)
One of the top public golf courses in the USA welcomes golfers from across the globe to play. The main dining room and bar area offer spectacular views across the rolling manicured fairways, eventually dropping off into the rolling waves of Lake Michigan. Many who have gazed out from the deck have said this view is one that defines "Pure Michigan." The Bluffs course, Lodge and Main Dining Room are open through Thanksgiving.



18 ARCADIA MARSH TRAIL

(On M-22 in Arcadia)
This boardwalk thru the Arcadia Marsh will offer panoramic views of fall color on the foliage surrounding the marsh and provide you with unforgettable images of wildlife. At about two miles out and back, it is a perfect spot to get out and stretch your legs while enjoying fall color in the area.

19 ARCADIA OVERLOOK (INSPIRATION POINT)

(On M-22 north of Arcadia)
The view from the Arcadia Overlook is one of "Pure Michigan's" most memorable and popular. You will see the parking lot packed during the fall as people climb up the 120 steps to the top of the scenic overlook. You can see clearly south to Arcadia, Onekama and Manistee.

20 OLD BALDY UNIVERSAL ACCESS TRAIL TO THE BLUFF

This universally accessible trail is about 0.5 miles and will take you to the overlook. All skill levels are encouraged to experience this incredible trail. If you have more time, and are up to the challenge, hike the complete trail to the Old Baldy Dune. This will take about 2 hours to hike out and back. The trails leading up to the overlook are spectacular and the color is sure to impress. You will feel like you are at Sleeping Bear Dunes but with a fraction of the people.

21 GRAVITY HILL

Visit the special section of Putney Rd. known as Gravity Hill and try to answer the age-old question, "If the car is in neutral, why does it seem to be rolling up a hill?" Some call it an optical illusion, others call it a mystical anomaly. Try it on a skateboard or bike too. Putney Rd. crosses Joyfield Rd. between US- 31 and M-22. Travel south from Joyfield Rd. and stop at a point 150 to 200 ft. beyond the "Stop Ahead" sign on the east side of the road, then put your car in neutral. You will roll all the way back up the hill to the Blaine Christian Church.


